

PROPHET -The meaning of the word

Made up of 2 Greek words: *pro-* & *-phetes*

The root of the word “*phetes*” means – SAY

so prophesying is essentially a verbal activity.

“*Pro*” in Greek has 3 main meanings:

1. Temporal – before in time
2. Spatial – in front of
3. Representative as in speaking on behalf of

Walked around naked & barefoot for 3 years as a sign to Ethiopia and Cush that their people will be dragged off naked and barefoot by the Assyrians (ch 20).



Micah

Briefly prophesied naked and barefoot to emphasize how devastating God's punishment on Judah and Israel will be (ch 1).
